

TEAM GROUND DUTY BY FIELD

Including Gymea Bay Oval, Kareela Oval and Waratah Park

Gymea Bay Oval

For more details, including diagrams of setup please see the accompanying document, GBO Field Setup and Pack-up.

Saturday Field Setup	<p>Time: 6:30 am – 9:30 am</p> <p>Two to three teams assigned to setup both fields (12 people*)</p> <p>Committee ground control will be there to guide you.</p> <p>Wear orange vests from Ground Control (8:00 – 9:30 am, 1 person per team.)</p>
Saturday Ground Control	<p>Time: see Roster</p> <p>One team assigned to cover both fields (3 people total, 1 per field minimum).</p> <p>Wear orange vests obtained from Ground Control.</p> <p>Be visible and step in for crowd control etc as required. For any issues, seek guidance from the committee member in Ground Control.</p>
Saturday Field Size Changes	<p>Time: Immediately before/after your game.</p> <p>As the last team playing on a certain size field, you will need to pack up immediately after your match (including goals and cones). See picture for Mini Goal return.</p> <p>If you are the first team to play on a new size field, you will need to setup your field goals.</p> <p>Need to be done with urgency as the next size field is scheduled to play and will cause game delays for the rest of the day if not done promptly.</p>
Saturday Field Pack-up	<p>Time: see Roster; finish after last game concluded.</p> <p>Includes ground control from start until end of game – wear orange vests from Ground Control (3 people total, 1 per field minimum).</p> <p>After games concluded, pack-up both fields (5 people*).</p> <p>Committee ground control will be there to guide you.</p>

* Some heavy lifting is required so please ensure that this is accounted for when communicating requirements to team. At least 2-4 people are required to lift the full field goals.

Gymea Bay Oval (continued ...)

Sunday Field Setup	Time: see Roster One team assigned to setup both fields (4-6 people*). Committee ground control will be there to guide you.
Sunday Field Pack-up	Pack-up: Minimum of 6 people to pack-up both fields*. Committee ground control will be there to guide you.

* Some heavy lifting is required so please ensure that this is accounted for when communicating requirements to team. At least 2-4 people are required to lift the full field goals.

MINI GOAL PACKUP (Vertical on shelf)



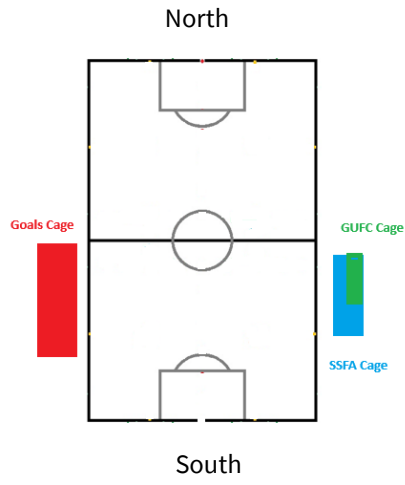

Saturday and Sunday Field Setup	<p>Time: 7:00 am – 8:00 am</p> <p>First team to play assigned to setup field (2 people)</p> <p>Kirrawee committee should have unlocked the goals cages. Position goals.</p> <p>Setup corner posts from cage:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Unlock the lockbox on the storage cage #1977;• Use the L1 key to open the padlock, then put back in lockbox and close.• Unlock the combo lock (#1960), take out flags and relock padlock. <p>Filling corner post holes with sand:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• There is a small Bunnings bucket in our cage;• Fill with sand from the Goals cage on the western side of the ground;• Top up the sand in the corner post holes as needed.
First Aid – Any Team	<p>First Aid Only (if needed):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Unlock the lockbox on the storage cage #1977;• Use the L1 key to open the padlock, then put back in lockbox and close.• Unlock the combo lock (#1960), take out flags and relock padlock.• Remove what first aid items from the tub that you require and relock cages.• Email admin@gufc.com.au with items that were removed so that they can be replaced.
Saturday Field Pack-up	<p>Time: after last game concluded.</p> <p>People needed: 2-4</p> <p>Lock goals back into goals storage cage. (No longer kept out on Saturday nights).</p> <p>Return corner posts to storage cage:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Unlock the lockbox on the storage cage #1977;• Use the L1 key to open the padlock, then put back in lockbox and close.• Unlock the combo lock (#1960), take out flags and relock padlock.
Sunday Field Pack-up	<p>Time: after last Gymea game concluded**.</p> <p>People needed: 2-4</p> <p>Return corner posts to storage cage:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Unlock the lockbox on the storage cage #1977;• Use the L1 key to open the padlock, then put back in lockbox and close.• Unlock the combo lock (#1960), take out flags and relock padlock. <p>If we are the last game of the day, lock goals back into goals storage cage (see above).</p>

If you are the first/last team playing at Kareela 3 on a Saturday you will need to follow the setup and pack-up instructions as for Kareela 2 under the direction of the Kirrawee ground control.

Goals are returned to the storage cage to the west of the field.

Waratah Park

Saturday or Sunday Field Setup	<p>Time: 7:00 am – 8:00 am</p> <p>Collect Waratah tub from Gymea Ground Control at 7am.</p> <p>First team to play assigned to setup field (4 people*)</p> <p>Unlock the container combination lock (#2227).</p> <p>Position the flags and attach nets to goals using Velcro straps.</p> <p>Put the tub on the half-way line.</p> <p>Key in the tub opens the toilets behind the tennis courts.</p>
Saturday or Sunday Field Pack-up	<p>Time: after last game concluded.</p> <p>Last team to play assigned to setup field (4 people*)</p> <p>Pack-up the nets and corner flags.</p> <p>Lock the container with the combination lock (#2227).</p> <p>Lock the toilets.</p> <p><u>Return the Waratah tub to Gymea Ground Control.</u> Do NOT leave in the container.</p>

* Some heavy lifting is required so please ensure that this is accounted for when communicating requirements to team. At least 2-4 people are required to lift the full field goals.
